# ALPENFROST Soup Cook-Off Regulations

When? Saturday, February 4, 2017

Where? Main Street Pavilion, Gaylord, MI

## Cooking Rules

1. All entries must be homemade. No box mix allowed.
2. All cooking supplies and ingredients are to be supplied by each cooking team.
3. Basic health codes for event cooking shall be followed during preparation and distribution of samples. It will be the responsibility of each team captain to maintain as healthy food-safe environment as possible throughout the event.
4. Each team is to make a minimum of 8 qts. (2gal) of their entrée – **3 gal is recommended!**
5. You must be set up and ready to serve by noon.
6. Serving time is from 11:30am-1:00pm for public sampling or until gone.

## Team Guidelines

1. Teams must pre-register in order to enter the contest, the entry form must be received no later than **January 12, 2017**. Space is limited, so register early.
2. Each team is to have a team name and team captain.
3. Contestants are responsible for supplying all of their own cooking utensils, etc.
4. Each team is to supply their own drinking water for cleaning and cooking.
5. Electrical power can be supplied to a limited number of teams, first come basis.
6. Team is to decorate their booth with an Alpenfrost winter theme. (*Optional*)
7. Teams will be permitted to set up their equipment, decorations and cooking areas anytime after 10:30am on Sat. February 4th. Loading and unloading will only be allowed in designated area.
8. Alpenfrost will NOT furnish any tables, chairs, or other supplies. All supplies are the responsibility of the contestants. (*Exception: Spoons & Tasting Bowls will be provided.*)
9. No team shall sell any samples or any other items direct to the public. (*Sampling spoons & bowls will be sold by Alpenfrost staff only.*)
10. Each team will have a 10x10 cooking area.
11. It will be the responsibility of each team to clean up their cooking site at the end of the evening. Trash receptacles will be provided by Alpenfrost.
12. **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** – No team will be allowed to bring alcohol onto Alpenfrost grounds.

## Alpenfrost Judging

1. Judging will be based on taste, appearance, texture, and service.
2. Each person purchasing a spoon will use it to judge your entrée by placing it in the bucket of the applicant with the best soup. **Winning teams will be announced around 1:00pm.**
3. The team with the highest score will receive a Prize, their name announced under the Pavilion, & Bragging Rights!



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
